



Gas Regulator Safety

It has come to our attention that a number of gas regulators have been modified to alter the output. According to British Compressed Gases Association (BCGA) Codes of Practice anybody carrying out modifications becomes liable in the event of an incident. This would place liability on the Department, and University, therefore, these changes should not be made under any circumstances.

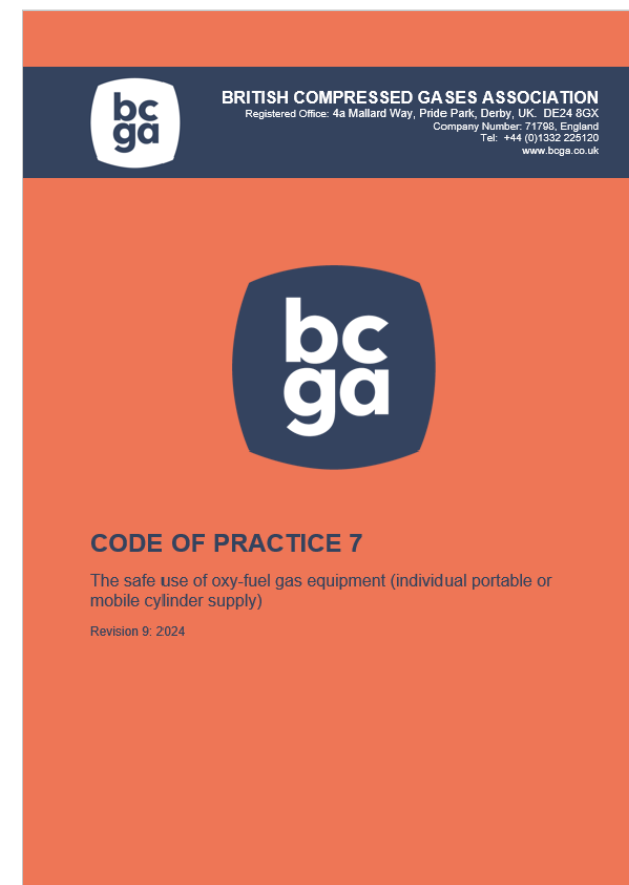


In order to comply with BCGA CP47 and CP7 the Department contracts BOC to undertake routine inspections of gas installations, which includes regulators. Any regulator which has been found to be modified will be failed upon inspection in line with the BCGA guidance.
